The CIVITAS Initiative



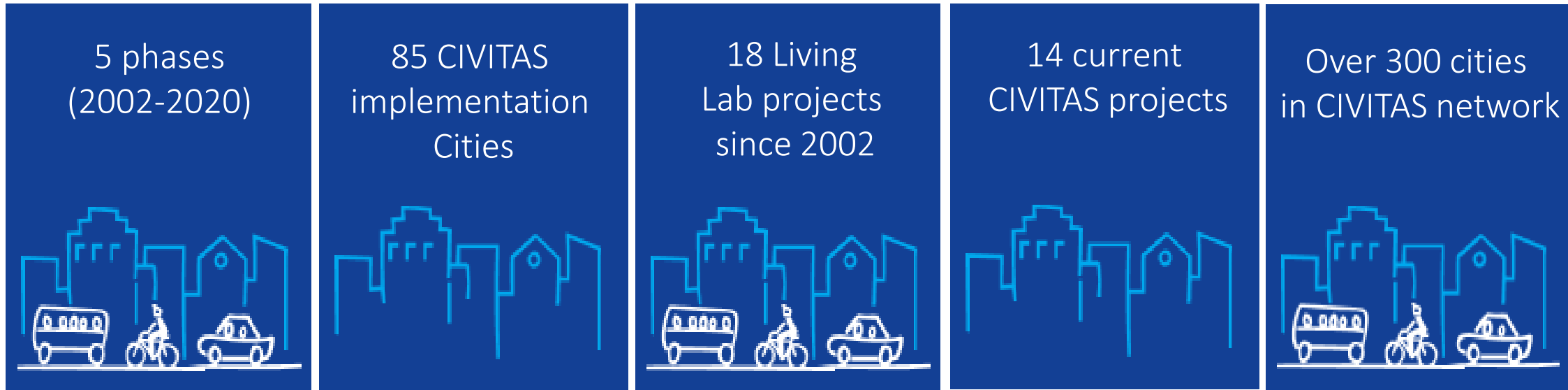
- The European-funded CIVITAS initiative brings over 15 years of testing integrated packages of urban mobility policies and measures to address transport and related energy and environmental goals in cities.
